

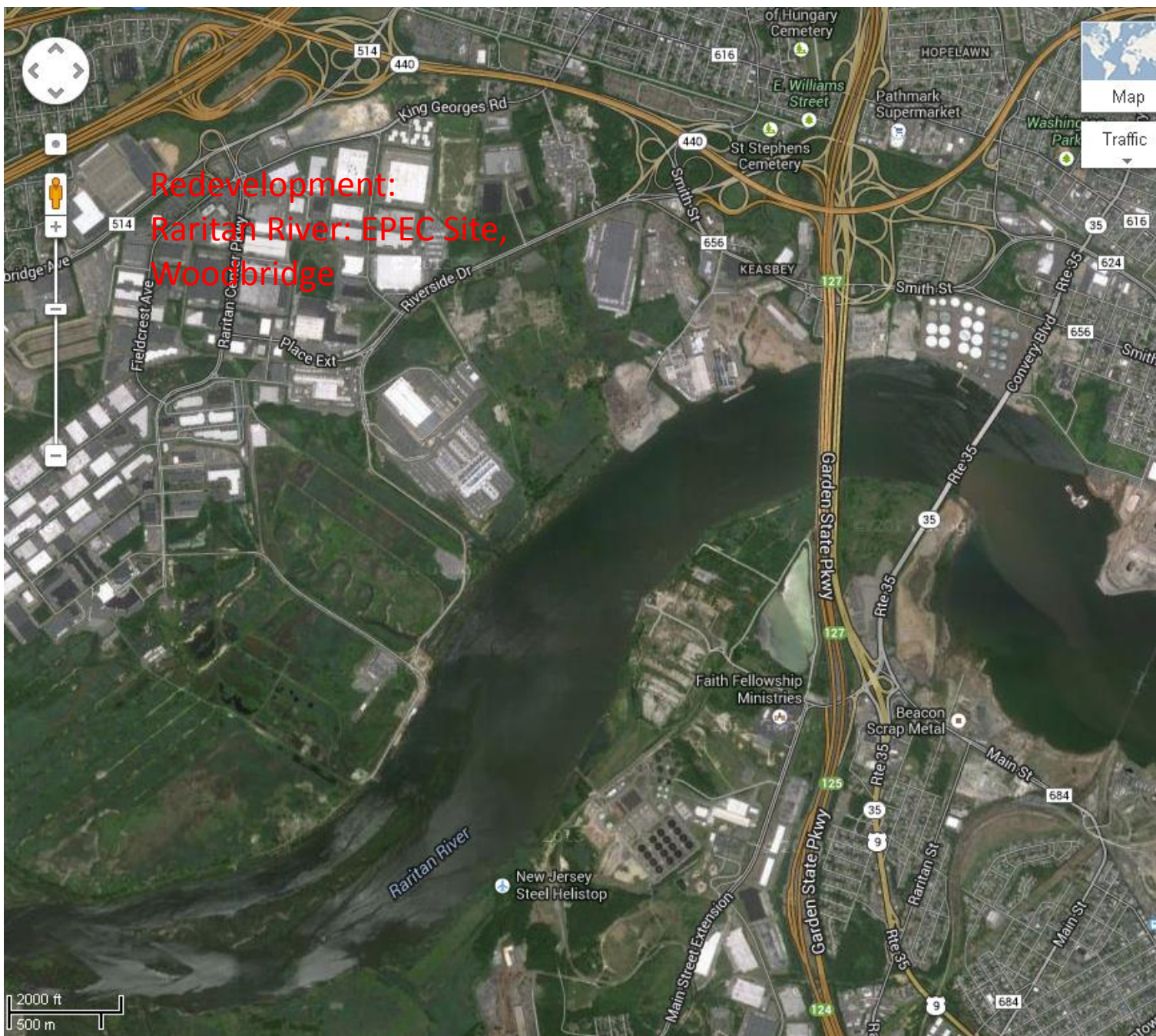

Energy Park (700 MW natural-gas fired plant (27 acres))

Restoration of 120 acres, to include trails and waterfront park

NJDEP Public Access Rule: Adopted Nov. 2012

Major Changes from
previous rule:

- Voluntary Municipal Public Access Plans
- Creation of Municipal Public Access Funds
- Elimination of Off-site Mitigation Requirement along majority of urban coastline
