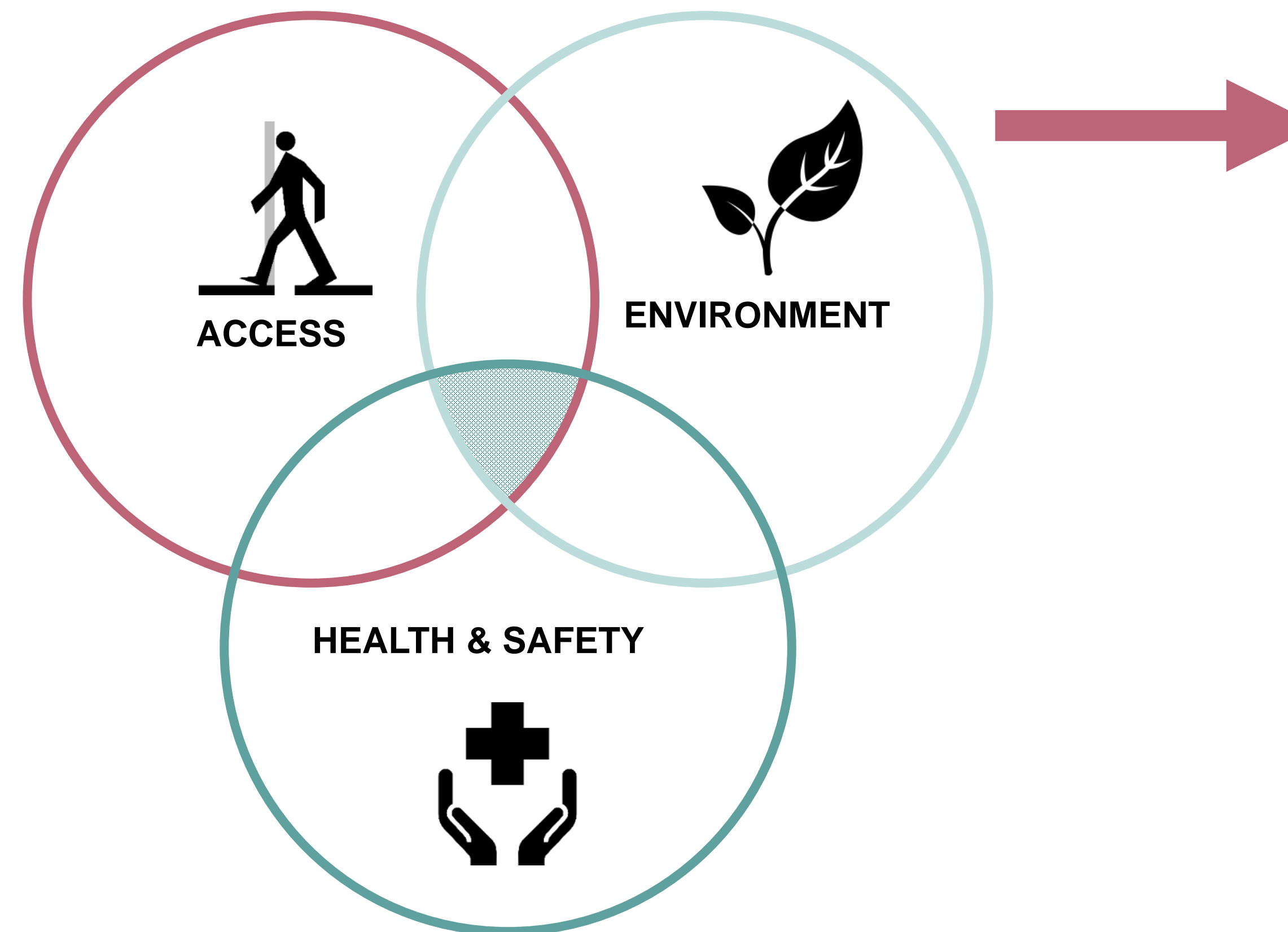
Proposed multimodal bridge and boardwalk
